Change of Morning Procedures as from Monday 14th November

We are going to trial a change in our morning procedures and would be very grateful for your support with this. The school day will still start officially at 8.55am but we would like to encourage children to come in for 8.45am in order to take part in some fun basic number fact activities in their classrooms. These activities will be based around consolidating number facts such as number bonds and multiplication tables which are even more important for the children to progress in their learning with the raised bar of the new National Curriculum.

The plan is for children to be on the playground for 8.45am where possible at which point the bell will be rung and children will be asked to say good bye to their parents before lining up in their year groups. They will then be taken to their classrooms where they can take part in the maths activities. Children arriving after 8.45am will be directed to the outside door to their classroom by Mrs Milling and Mrs Rimmer where they can join their class and the maths activities. The register will be taken as usual at 8.55am. Children attending the breakfast club will be brought up to the playground for 8.45am. Please note that the playground will not be supervised before 8.45am. Parents may continue to take nursery aged children straight to St Cuby class if this benefits their child. We would be grateful if parents of children in St Ladoca class could continue to park in the car park even if arriving after 8.45am as this avoids cars turning where children maybe walking to class.

Wake and Shake will continue to take place but later in the morning at 10.45am when the children will benefit more from some movement and brain oxygenation!

I am sure there may be a few teething problems with this plan at first but please bear with us and give it a chance as we have our children and their learning as our main concern. As always we are very receptive to any comments or feedback you may have about this.
