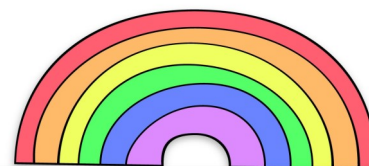

## A Note from Mr Stoyles

A warm welcome back to everyone. We hope that you all had an enjoyable half term break. This week we were pleased to begin serving hot meals cooked from our kitchen to the children in school. Transporting, packaging, serving the meals hot, and on time, was always going to prove a logistical challenge but this is something we are proud to have accomplished without any major issues. Across four days, the school served approximately 240 meals that were delivered to class bubbles. Usually, the children would choose their dessert when collecting their food but this choice now needs to be made through Parent Pay. Please choose only one option for dessert and ensure that the lunch order is made, at the latest, the evening before the lunch is served. This is because meal lists are delivered to the kitchen first thing in the morning.

The school PTFA meeting took place via Zoom on Tuesday, where discussions were centred around how the group can continue to support the school by providing a number of enriching experiences for the children moving into the Christmas period. Aware of restrictions in place, there were lots of ideas around how traditional events and activities could be adapted to suit current guidance. These plans will be published in the newsletter next week.

Further guidance for schools based on national restrictions were released on Wednesday ([click here for guidance](#)). In summary, relating to Ladock school:

- The day-to-day timings and general provision in school remains unchanged.
- Children categorised as clinically extremely vulnerable will receive a letter from their doctor advising them on school attendance.
- Schools should continue to restrict visits to those that are absolutely necessary
- Schools are able to work with external sports coaches for curricular activities when it is safe to do so.

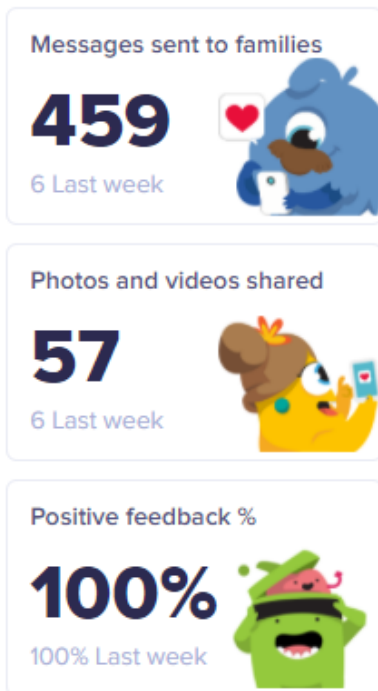

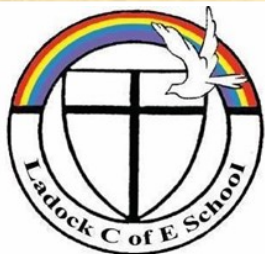

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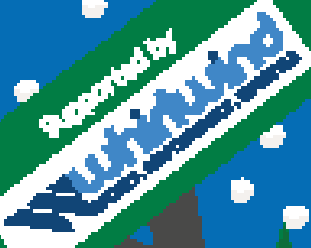
