#### A Note from Mr Stoyles

I hope that you have all had a fantastic week and are able to now enjoy the weekend. We extend our thanks for all the harvest donations received — our school corridor is now packed and the donations will be a blessing for those in need. Our annual harvest festival took place virtually in class bubbles today. Each class produced a short video that included prayers, poems and bible readings that the children thoroughly enjoyed making as well as watching. We thank Miss Harris for organising this event.



We have now updated our school medical policy and compiled a medical needs list based on the data collection sheets submitted at the beginning of the school term. If you have notified the school that your child suffers from asthma, and they require an inhaler/spacer to be kept in their classroom, please notify a member of staff on the school gate and supply this to them labelled with the child's name. We have also revised how the school will administer prescribed medications. If medication needs to be administered in school, we ask that you complete the attached file within this email and send to Jane via the email address in the top banner of this newsletter. Please pass the medication to a member of staff on the school gate. If you are unsure about this process, please contact the school where we will be happy to make alternate arrangements. A link to this document will be included in the school newsletter each week for ease of access.

During our staff meeting on Wednesday this week, we discussed how we can provide remote education for children required to isolate that closely matches the learning taking place in class. From the beginning of the next half term, if a period of isolation is required, you will be sent a private message via Class Dojo containing a single attached pdf file. This will include: numeracy lessons being taught in class, literacy and topic activities that are focussed around your child's current class topic, as well as their spelling list and different extension activities. This will be a two-week programme that may, or may not, be used in its entirety. You may wish to submit completed work through the portfolio for marking. Remote learning plans for bubble or whole school closure remain unchanged and can be viewed in the school reopening guide.

Your child's summary report detailing how well they have settled into the new academic year will be emailed to you on Wednesday 21st October, replacing the traditional October parent consultation evening. If your child has specific learning targets, you will be contacted by phone to discuss these next week.

Although some schools across Cornwall have opted to extend their half term break, we remain committed to welcome children back on Tuesday 3rd November after our planned inset day on Monday 2nd November.

An important target within our school recovery plan is based around clear communication to parents. Although there is lots of information within this newsletter, we hope that you find it a useful central source of information.


