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A note from Mr Stoyles

Good afternoon, I hope you are all well and enjoying the great weather recently. Today marks the end of the SATS period for the children in Year 6. We are incredibly proud of their efforts and feel they dealt with the intense period incredibly well. A special thanks also goes to all members of staff, parents, volunteers and Mr Nicholson.

In a constant effort to continue to improve standards of behaviour within school at lunchtimes, we will be launching a lunchtime reflection zone in Cuby classroom. This area will be run on a rota basis by teachers each lunchtime beginning after the half term break.

If lunchtime supervisors on duty feel a child would benefit from taking a period of 10 minutes to reflect on their actions, they will be taken into Cuby classroom to meet the teacher on duty. During this time, they will be asked first to complete a reflection sheet. Next, a brief conversation will take place to ensure the child understands steps to resolve any issues they may have caused, this could be apologising verbally to those involved. If the incident is deemed severe, the child will be given an additional task or activity to complete before returning to their lunch break.

We believe that this strategy will further improve behaviour at lunchtimes as well as allow more time to investigate any playground incidents. Once again, thank you for you support. If you would like to discuss this any further, please feel free to arrange an appointment to meet with me.

Collecting children at the end of the day

Please can we remind parents that it is **essential** that children are collected promptly at 3.15 at the end of the day. In order to ensure their safety, children not collected by 3.25pm (unless parents have been in touch with the school) will be taken to after school club and will need to be collected from there. Parents will be charged the normal after school club rate of £3.00 for the first hour, £5.00 until 5pm, and £6.50 until 5.30pm.
