



A Note from Mr Stoyles

You may be aware that schools across the country have been granted with additional funds from the government named as the 'Coronavirus Catch-Up Premium.' This is to further close the gap on missed time in education as a result of school closure. For primary schools, this is calculated at £80 per child from reception to year six credited in three payments throughout the school year. During our most recent staff meeting, we discussed how this money could be used to the best benefit of children both academically and emotionally and, in keeping with our school target of transparency, we will publish our spending plans to parents in due course.

You will have received your child's Christmas card design for you to order should you wish. Instructions with a web link and your child's unique PIN code for ordering are on the cards.


The deadline for ordering cards is 14th November
