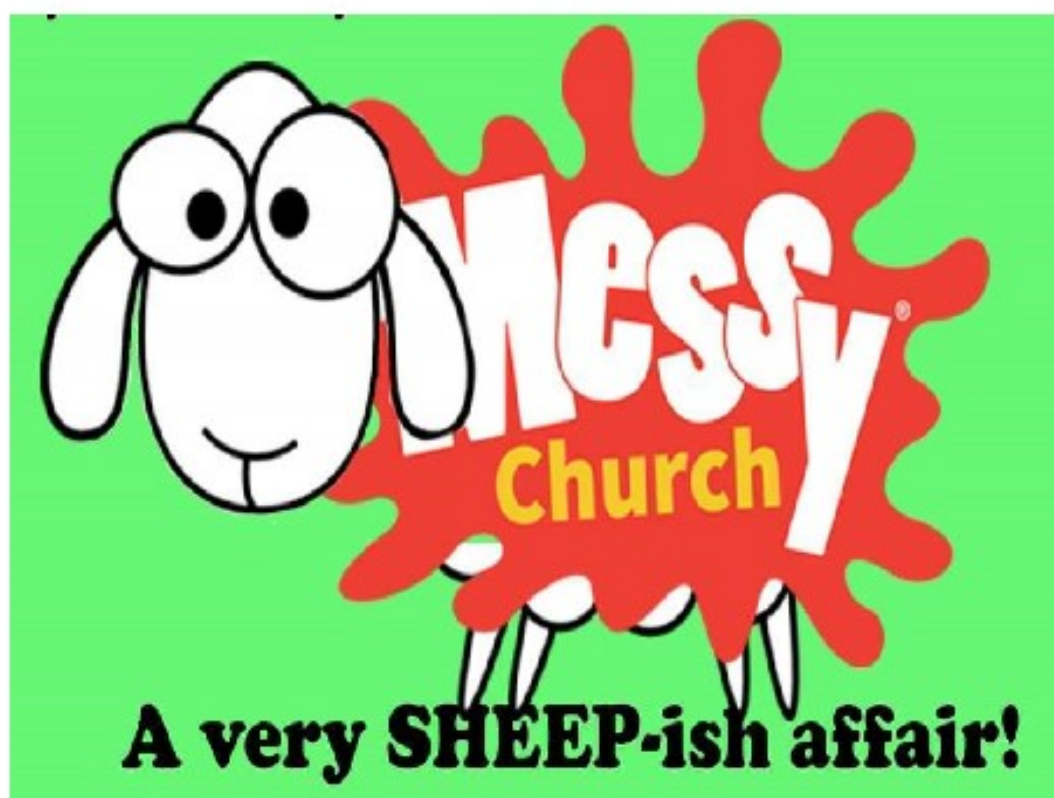
Cross country after school club (KS2) review 1st half of Spring term 2020

In the weeks leading up to half term, the KS2 Cross Country after school club looked at the differences in technique between running in the country compared to road and track running - cross country running requires a different stride length (shorter to minimise slipping), a different foot plant (point the toes slightly outwards to maximize grip) and a different leg action (higher knee lift as more difficult to push off from soft ground).

We then put this into practice using each of the elements that would go into a training plan. So one week we did a longer endurance run, one week a session of hill reps and another week a fartlek session varying the pace between jogging and sprinting.
