Newquay Tretherras Consultation on School Admission Arrangements for 2021/22

Dates for Consultation: 17th October 2019 to 28th November 2019

Newquay Education Trust, as the admission authority for Newquay Tretherras, is proposing changes to the admissions arrangements to the school for the academic year 2021/22.

In line with the School Admissions Code, admission authorities are required to consult on their admission policy whenever they would like to make a change.

The main proposed change to the policy is to the over-subscription criteria. This now includes equal weighting to all our school's main feeder primary schools, rather than the schools being split into two groups, as they have been up until now.

The proposed admissions policy for 2021/22 is on the school's website (tretherras.net). Alternatively, copies can be obtained from the school on request.
