## Year 6 taster day at The Roseland School Tuesday 2 July 2019

Buses will allow access to Year 6 students on Welcome Day Tuesday 2 July with the usual caveats. Cornwall Council advise that all parents accompany Year 6 students to the bus stop, as although they are allowed to travel, there is no guarantee that all of the new intake will be able to get on the bus. If the vehicle becomes overloaded, students will be refused access

Once the students arrive at school, they should enter the school through the student entrance. This is by the tennis courts and will be where everyone else is going. They then will gather in the hall. Staff will be on hand to help and support students who will meet them all in the hall.

At the end of the day, all students will exit through the student entrance and get on the bus or go to their lift. If the student came on the bus, they will be able to return on the bus. If there are no spaces in the morning (has never happened but doesn't mean it couldn't) parents should drop in their child and collect them at the end of the school day.

weed seeds. It was delicious! A big thank you to Matt and to all the parents that joined in.




#### **Foodbank Collection**
