I hope that you have an enjoyable weekend.





School Uniform Information reminder



- ◆ Dark grey tailored shorts or trousers for boys and girls
- ◆ Or dark grey skirts or pinafores for girls
- ◆ White polo shirts with or without the school logo
- ◆ Red sweatshirts **WITH** the school logo (no fleeces or hoodies)
- ◆ Or red cardigans **WITH** the school logo for girls
- ◆ Tights for girls must be red or grey
- ◆ Grey or white socks must be worn with shorts/skirts/dresses
- ◆ Girls may wear red and white checked summer dresses
- ◆ Closed toe, black shoes must be worn (**NO TRAINERS**)
- ◆ PE uniform – Plain black shorts/jogging bottoms, plimsolls/trainers, round necked red t-shirt **with** school logo
- ◆ Long hair to be tied back

Parenting is not an easy job, and at times things can get tough.

Parent Support Advisors are here to help provide a seamless link between home and school that promotes a positive attitude towards education.



What we do:

- Encouraging positive links between parent/carer and school.
- Help parent/carer feel confident to engage with their child's learning.
- Assist and support around transition stages.
- Help with issues around attendance.
- Signposting to other agencies.
- Enable participation in the Common Assessment Framework (CAF).
- Deliver evidence-based parenting programmes.

- Targeted individual pupil support.
- Working to an action plan with a family on identified needs.
- Parenting groups, various ages and needs.
- Meetings which can take place within school, at home or in a neutral venue.
- Initiate and support families with the CAF process.
- Linking with primary schools to identify and give additional support to some pupils during the transition process.

Attendance



As you know Celtic Cross Education have developed a RAG (red/amber/green) rated system to alert parents to the fact that attendance is falling;

GREEN Band—93—96%

AMBER Band 90-93%

RED Band—Persistent Absentee) Below 90% (This is a Government definition).

An attendance trawl will take place at the end of the Autumn term and letters will be sent to parents whose children fall into the above categories. We understand that children may have to attend a medical/dental appointment in school time, however you should try to make routine appointments outside of school hours.

If children do not attend school regularly, they may not be able to keep up with school work. In a busy school day, it is difficult for teachers to find the extra time for a child to catch up.

Every lesson really does matter, also missing out on the social side of school life—especially at primary school—can affect a child’s ability to make and keep friendships, a vital part of growing up. Children can become unnecessarily worried about the return to school, causing a barrier to returning.



You will need to apply even if your child attends a school's nursery or pre-school class. Please note that if a school is oversubscribed the fact that a child attends a school's nursery or pre-school, or a local nursery or pre-school, does not automatically guarantee a place at that school. 1 Decide on your preferred schools

You are strongly advised to name **three** preferences on the application form. Naming a second or third preference does not give you any less chance of getting a place at your preferred school. When making your decision you should...

...think about how your child will get to school. Go to www.cornwall.gov.uk/schooltransport for more information on whether your child would be entitled to transport to school.

...look at the **admission arrangements** on our website that will be used to allocate places for each school.

...consider naming your **nearest or designated school** as one of your preferences. You can find your nearest or designated school on our website.

...look at the detailed **admissions information** on our website, also available on request.

2 Submit your application by **31 October 2021**

3 Wait to find out which school you have been allocated

If you applied on time you will be notified of your allocation on **National Offer Day: 1 March 2022**. **Apply on time!** Late applications will only be dealt with after National Offer Day and there may not be any places left at your preferred schools.
