## Back In Time -

Doors open, and tea and coffee will be served, from 12.45 and 5.30. Children should not arrive any earlier than 5.30 (as there will be no staff available to supervise) and no later than 5.45 please. The afternoon performance should be finished by approximately 2.15. Parents attending the afternoon play will be able to take their children from the Village Hall but must tell staff before they leave. If another family member is attending the play and parents would like them to collect their child, they must have contacted the school prior to the performance with the name of the person who has their permission to collect the child. For safety reasons, we will not be able to allow any child to leave after the afternoon performance without this being in place.

We will return all the children not collected to school for the normal pick up time of 3.15pm. Children will go home in costume and should return still in costume for the evening performance. This should be finished by 7.10pm to allow time for the raffle to be drawn. Again, when collecting children please let a member of staff know. We will line the children up in the corridor leading to the room behind the stage and dismiss them from there as has happened in previous years.

You will be presented with a log-in screen where you will need to enter your name, your email address (if you enter your email address, you will receive an email confirmation of your booking) and your child's name and DOB. You can then log on and continue with your booking(s). You can choose your child's class/teacher, and either day 1 or day 2. It is very straight forward, but if you do have a problem, or do not have access to the internet, please speak to Jane, who can make the booking(s) for you.

## **Parent Pay outstanding accounts**

## **New school lunch caterers**

As you know, from September 2017, our new school lunch caterer will be Caterlink. Their new menus have been published on line, and the good news is that the price for a school meal will remain at £2.30.

Unfortunately, Caterlink do not offer the '5 for 4' option for meals, this means that the cost for 5 meals will be £11.50. KS1 children will still receive free school meals, but they still need to be booked via Parentpay.

You will need to bring your bike into school (Emma will bring one in for the three children she spoke to).

If you have a bike padlock, bring that too as we will padlock the bikes to the 'farm' gate.

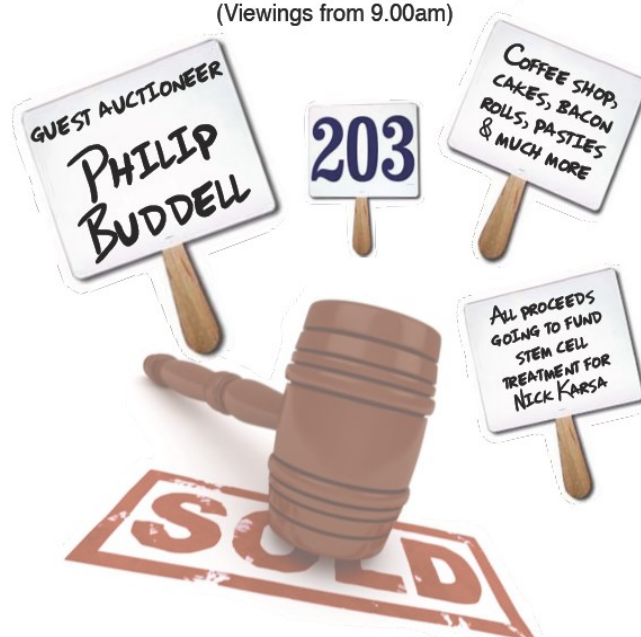

## Parent Governor election

As more than one person has returned an application to become a parent governor of Ladock School, a ballot has been arranged. Please find enclosed with your Newsletter 2 ballot papers with supporting documents from the two candidates.

Each ballot paper, however returned to the school, should be in a plain sealed envelope, which in turn is inside a sealed envelope. **Please write your name and your child(ren)'s name on the outside of the outer envelope.** This 'double envelope' system is necessary so that parents voting can be checked against the school register as a way of ensuring only those entitled to take part in the ballot actually do so and the ballot remains secret.

Each parent of a registered pupil at the school is entitled to vote, including the candidates standing for election.

You may vote for 1 candidate by placing 'X' in the right hand column against your choice.

**The ballot count will take place at 9.30 am on 25th July at the school, so please ensure that your vote is returned to school before 9.00am on this date. You will find a sealed box in the reception area for you to post your votes.**



## Year 5/6 Internet Safety afternoon

On Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> July we are having an internet safety afternoon, the Year 5 & 6 children will take part in a Workshop at Grampound Village Hall from 1.30 to 3 pm with a visiting trainer from SWGFL (South West Grid for Learning). This will be for all the village schools in our MAT. Children will be travelling to Gramound with Creed school on a coach. **We will assume that you give permission for your child to attend this MAT event which is part of their curriculum, unless you contact us.**

There will also be an Internet Safety Workshop in the evening for Year 5/6 Parents and Governors who are interested in finding out more about internet safety and how to keep our children safe online at home. This will include valuable information and tips on how to manage your child's access to the internet, games and apps to be aware of and a chance to ask questions and air concerns with an expert.

This session will run from 6.30 to 8.00pm on July 20<sup>th</sup> at Grampound Road School.

If you cannot make this date, there is another session at Bishop Bronescombe on the 19<sup>th</sup> July from 6.30 to 8.00pm which you are also welcome to attend.
