Desired Outcomes

Teaching Assistant Staffing - £28,656.00

Ladock School KPI3 Target - Increase the percentage of PP/DIS pupils making accelerated progress across the school in reading, writing and maths.

- Members of staff aware of which children throughout the school are Pupil Premium.
- Regular TA afternoon intervention support through 'personalised learning' same day intervention.
- Pupil Premium monitoring focus what support is in place/how are these children processing?
- SMC monitoring visit focus on Pupil Premium children.
- Pupil Premium children to be a focus during termly Pupil Progress meetings.
- Training for 'champions' throughout the school dyslexia, autism, TIS.
- Trauma in Schools (TIS) training for all members of staff.
- Siblings Club, to allow time for children with a sibling with time consuming needs to take part in activities during school hours.





Parent Support Advisor - Kathleen Mauris - £1000.00

Parent Support Adviser employed across Roseland Feeder schools, contribution based around predicted intervention from Pupil Premium children. With support from Kathy, we believe that social and emotional barriers will be improved leading to an increase in academic performance.

- A decrease in persistent absentees
- Increase links and communication between parents and teachers throughout the school
- Promote social communication and a 'place to talk' about anxieties

External Consultants/Professionals - £600.00

Ann Key – Children's Behaviour Support & Advice (Theraplay based practice)

Requested to analyse and work with children to help build and enhance attachment, self-esteem, trust in others and joyful engagement through organised Theraplay practitioner sessions.

Curriculum - £459.00

Ladock School KPI3 Target - Increase the percentage of PP/DIS pupils making accelerated progress across the school in reading, writing and maths.

SATS interventions

(Year 6 - 78% PP)

Teaching Assistant overtime/external agency core subject intervention.

Individual SATS booster club afterschool/in-school interventions to be arranged for Pupil Premium children in the build up to their end of year assessments. This will help close gaps in learning and support accelerated progress.

Times Fables - £40.00 (x8)

Purchase for Pupil Premium in Y5/6.
