## A Note from Mr Stoyles

The new guidance regarding Covid-19 has been published and reflects what has been covered on the news in the past few days. In short, 'if your child is not feeling well enough to be in school, they should stay at home and if they are well, they should carry on attending.' This means that children off school today are welcome to attend on Monday morning, providing they feel well enough. However, if your child is ill with a high temperature then they should isolate for a maximum of three days. There isn't now any requirement to test but we understand that some may continue to do this. This is of course a significant change and we understand people will see this as the 'new normal' at different rates.

Next week we have our school SIAMS inspection. The overall judgement of the school is based on the question:

"How effective is the school's distinctive Christian vision, established and promoted by leadership at all levels, in enabling pupils and adults to flourish?"

This is examined across seven strands that include:

1. Vision and Leadership
2. Wisdom, Knowledge, and Skills
3. Character Development: Hope, Aspiration, and Courageous Advocacy
4. Community and Living Well Together
5. Dignity and Respect
6. Impact of Collective Worship
7. Effectiveness of Religious Education.

## Cold weather routine or other emergencies

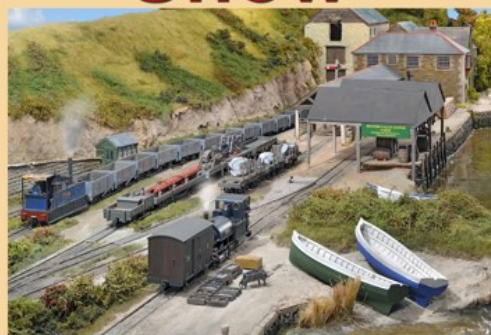
At this point of the year as the weather begins to turn colder it is worth reiterating our cold weather and emergency closures plans.

### The School Nurse can check:
