



30 hours funding for Autumn Funding Block 2019 (1st September to 31st December 2019)

This is a reminder that parents who wish to begin claiming 30 hours funding from 1st September 2019 must receive their code by 31st August 2019 at the very latest.

• Please ensure you start this process as soon as possible HMRC recommend parents begin their application by the end of July to allow time for the claim to be processed

Please also remember to check your **Entitlement Expiration Dashboard** for codes that are due to expire (amber) or have already expired (red).

For codes that show as amber and red, in order for extended hours funding to continue in September 2019, it is very important that you log in to your childcare account with HMRC and re-confirm your details as soon as possible.

Codes that have a grace period end date of 31st August 2019 must be re-validated by that date, at the very latest, for extended hours to be paid from 1st September 2019. HMRC recommend that parents do this by the end of July to ensure the process is completed on time.

- After re-confirming your details and if found to still be eligible the end date will be extended.
- However, if found to be no longer eligible extended hours funding will stop at the end of August.

You will not be able to claim extended hours funding from 1st September 2019 for any child:

- whose code has a grace period end date of 31st August 2019
- whose code has a start date of 1st September 2019 or later
