#### CORNWALL SCHOOLS GAMES REVIEW by Mr Nicholson

Last Friday a team from Ladock School took part in the Cornwall Schools Games Finals at Penryn College and Falmouth University. This was a fantastic experience with 3,000 competitors taking part across a wide range of sports. The opening ceremony brought everyone

together and was hosted by a presenter from Heart FM Radio which included dancers, a mass aerobic work- out, giant confetti cannons and an inspiring interview with Molly Caudery, a student at Truro College who earlier this year finished an amazing 5<sup>th</sup> place in the Commonwealth Games in Australia in Pole Vault. Molly presented a pennant to a member from every team participating who were all welcomed onto the big stage (with an even bigger sound system!)

Ladock were one of eight finalists who had qualified for the Badminton finals, having won through from the local area and Mid Cornwall tournaments earlier in the year. The teams were put into two groups and the standard was high. After losing our opening game to Pendeen school, the Ladock team of Isaac, James, Jemima and Aeisha played superbly in their second match to win against Bude school. The third game was very close against Godolphin school. The group order was decided by the total number of points won, and Ladock finished runners up in their group which was a great achievement. This meant they played the runners up of the other group (St Francis from Falmouth), to see who would finish third overall in a bronze medal match (yes, there really were medals!). Ladock played really well (and were even winning in the early stages), but a very strong St Francis team just managed to pull clear as the game went on to take the match. To finish 4<sup>th</sup> overall in entire county for a small school like Ladock was a superb achievement – well done!


