Annual nasal flu vaccinations— Reception, Years 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5

Kernow Health are once again delivering the flu immunisation programme in Cornwall's schools on behalf of NHS England.

In 2018/19 all children in Reception and school years 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 will be offered the vaccine.

This year, Kernow Health are introducing a digital consent, otherwise known as e-consent, which will take away a significant part of the administration and paper-trails. In summary e-consent will mean:

- No paper (unless you would prefer paper)
- A simple email letter to you with instructions.
- No consent forms coming back to school – they will be sent electronically to Kernow Health.
- Contact details for Kernow Health on all communications

Parents will be emailed the letters from school with simple instructions, if you do have difficulty, please speak to Jane in the school office. It would be appreciated if these could be completed for Kernow Health asap.

Parent pay

We would like to ask parents whenever possible, to use Parentpay as the first port of call for bookings and payments, including breakfast/after-school club, trips and school dinners.

If the booking is made online, the payment is processed immediately meaning a debt isn't incurred on Parentpay. This also gives time for the school meals register to be processed and delivered to the kitchen. The school currently has 27 unpaid debts and we would appreciate parents checking the website to see if there are any amounts outstanding.

If you are in a rush, or would like to order a school meal and do not have internet access, there will be a laptop outside the school office for you to do this beginning next Monday.

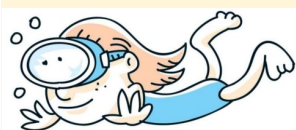
