Will you impress Mr Cornish? Each week you must choose one written task, handing your completed work in by each Thursday. What task will you choose first? **You only need to complete five of the tasks - you can leave the one you most despise!**

<p>Task 1: Lego Batman (or any creation toy)</p> <p>Have you seen the Lego Batman movie? If not, no worries. Write a list of instructions to build the ultimate Lego creation. It could be a bat-mobile or a bat-cave. You could build it and take a photograph!</p>	<p>Task 2: Scooters (or similar).</p> <p>Would you like your own scooter? Or skateboard? Or something similar? Write a persuasive speech to passionately tell your parents you need this item! You could record yourself and email it to the school office.</p>
<p>Task 3: Plastic Fantastic</p> <p>Plastics are polluting our oceans. It's never been worse! It's on the news every day. Record or write a report to share what you discover through research.</p>	<p>Task 4: Newspaper Article</p> <p>Some things are so annoying! What annoys you? No, you can't write about me! Choose a topic and write a passionate newspaper article to share your opinion about your chosen topic.</p>
<p>Task 5: Happiness</p> <p>What is happiness? How can you improve your happiness? What makes you happy? Create a poster to tell the world!</p>	<p>Task 6: Comedy</p> <p>Do you know any good jokes? Write a stand-up comedy show, telling anecdotal stories or your best jokes. Ask your family for their ideas. If you'd like, stand up and share it in class!</p>

- You must think about your presentation, your spelling, your grammar and your paragraphing.
- You might produce a plan before you write your text.
- You might word process your text, print it off, and add it to your homework book.
