## Recycling!

The war on plastics is heightening all around us. In December last year Walkers joined with a company called Terracycle and launched a scheme to recycle crisp packets. Since then over 11 million packets have been recycled and more and more companies are signing up to these recycling schemes, reducing the amount of waste ending up in landfill and our beautiful seas. At school we are joining the #waronplastic working with Terracycle to recycle all brands of crisp packets, biscuit & cake wrappers and chocolate & sweet wrappers! This is a great way to teach children there are many ways to recycle items that are not within our standard household recycling. If you would like to get recycling at home please do! You can bring your items into school and we will add them to our collection. **Please just make sure all packets are empty and flat.**

We also have a separate box for you to recycle empty toothpaste tubes, cartons, tops, toothbrushes or toothbrush packaging.

The recycling boxes will be in the reception area.

**This recycling scheme DOES NOT accept the following waste:-**

Baby wipe packets  
Bread bags (these can be recycled with carrier bags at larger supermarkets)  
Carrier bags  
Plastic post bags/envelopes  
Cling film  
Plastic coffee bags  
Cereal/Muesli bar wrappers  
Yoghurt tubes  
Dried fruit snack packets  
Meat or cheese wrappers/packets  
Packaging used for fruit/vegetables  
Ice pop tubes

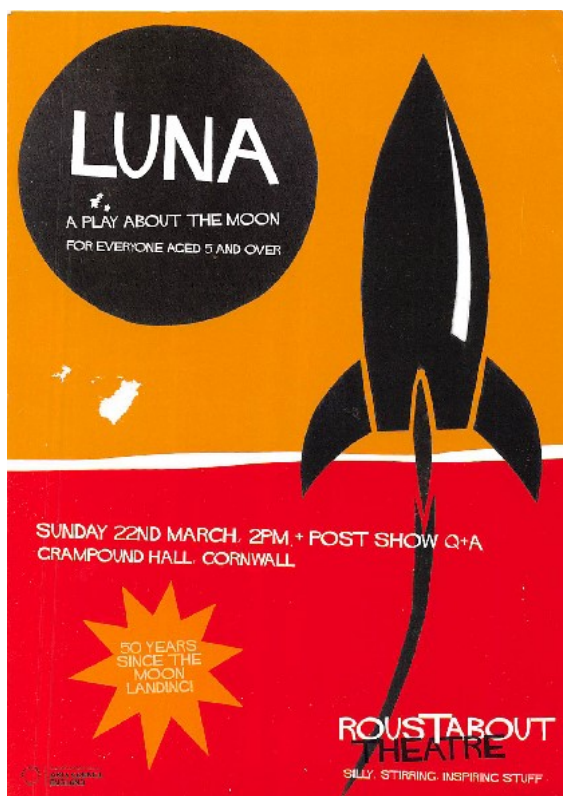
