I hope that you all have had a wonderful week and are looking forward to the upcoming weekend.

On Tuesday, we were joined by Russell Wilcock for the children's individual/siblings photographs. With a number of absences across the school on the day, we have arranged for Russell to join us again on Tuesday 30th November to take photographs of those that were not present.

Our school remembrance service took place on Thursday. Blaise class led this and confidently shared a number of poems to the rest of the school. This was followed by a 2 minute silence to remember those who sacrificed their lives during the war. All of the children were brilliant during this and we are immensely proud of all their efforts.



Today, some of the children in school had their nasal flu vaccinations. If you were unable to complete the form and would still like for your child/children to have their vaccination a further date is being arranged and this will be communicated to you in due course.

A Note from Mr Stoyles

In response to parent feedback in the summer term, we are now at the final stages of booking swimming sessions for all children in Keyne, Ladoca and Blaise. This will run across three separate weeks and take place in the mornings at Polkyth leisure centre (Monday-Friday), maximising children's time in the water. Sessions for Keyne and Ladoca are likely to take place in January and Blaise classes swimming sessions will be in the summer term.

On Thursday this week, some of our children in KS2 travelled to Woodland Valley farm to be apart of a national radio broadcast airing on Fun Kids Radio (DAB) about the beaver project. The children interviewed an 'eco-expert' and were joined by BBC's Springwatch Gillian Burke. We will make sure to record and share the broadcast when this goes live.

How to attend your appointments via video call

1. Log in and go to the Evening - [Click here](#) (<https://ladockprimary.schoolcloud.co.uk/>)

On the day of the video appointments (or before, if you want to test your camera and microphone) login to Parents Evening on the link above for your school, or click the login link from the bottom of the email confirmation you will have received.

Once logged in you will see a notice that you have upcoming video appointments and under this the details of the event, along with a *Join Video Appointments* button.

Press the button to join your appointment on the day - or to test your camera/microphone at any time.

In order to make video calls you need to have as a minimum:

- a device with a microphone and speaker/headphones
- a compatible up-to-date web browser: **iPhone/iPad:** Safari **Note: there is a known issue joining video calls using iOS 14.2. Please upgrade any iOS 14.2 devices to iOS 14.3, or use an alternate device.** **Android:** Chrome or Firefox **Windows:** Chrome, Firefox or Microsoft Edge (Chromium - [download here](#)) **Mac:** Safari, Chrome or Firefox **Linux:** Chrome or Firefox

We also recommend:

- Using your smartphone for video appointments. If you don't have a smartphone with a front-facing camera, use a laptop or computer with a webcam.
- Using a headset (or earphones with a microphone) to reduce echo.
