Attendance

As mentioned in previous Newsletters we have an obligation to make parents aware if their child's attendance drops below 96%. We will be monitoring all of our children's attendance every half term.

If your child's attendance has dropped below the national school target of 96% we will send home a letter making you aware of this. We are aware that for some of the children their absence is due to illness and whilst this is classed as an authorised absence it does still affect their overall percentage.

Please be assured we are not questioning why they have been absent from school. We have introduced 3 letters; Green Band—93-96%, Amber Band—90%-93% and Red Band (persistent absentee) - below 90% (This is a government definition.) The Green letter we send is purely to inform you that your child's attendance percentage has dropped below 96% and what it currently is.

Children who frequently miss school often fall behind, and there is a strong link between good school attendance and achieving good results.


