Thankyou to Gary from our Premises team for working so hard on the Victorian Building porch over the summer break and refurbishing it back to its 'former glory' It looks lovely!




Supporting The Lily Foundation

### **HEADLICE**

We have been contacted by a number of families who are struggling to get rid of head lice infestations from their children. If we notice that a child has head lice or nits (the empty egg shells), we will discreetly speak to their parent(s) and ask that the problem be tackled immediately. Gone are the days when we are permitted to check children's heads ourselves. Please appreciate that whilst we do all we can to support parents with information and reminders of how to tackle the head lice problem, it CANNOT be the school's responsibility to overcome the problem; this has to be down to the parents. Unless **EVERYONE** is diligent in checking their child's head and treating the problem, we will not break the cycle and head lice will continue to be a problem.

In a further attempt to work as a team and break the head lice cycle, we will be asking parents to support Bug Busting Day!

# TOMORROW (Friday 27th Sept) IS BUG BUSTING DAY!

Could we ask you all to check your child's hair for head lice and treat if necessary. If we all do this on the same day each month then we will be able to control this issue, although you do need to check your child's head more often than once a month.
